imeon, a resident of Jerusalem during the first century, experienced profound peace because of Jesus. Moved by the Holy Spirit, Simeon went to the temple when Mary and Joseph brought baby Jesus to be circúmcised as required by the law for a new born boy. Although not much is known about Simeon, from Luke's description one can tell he was a special man of God, just and devout, waiting faithfully for the coming Messiah, "and the Holy Spirit was on him" (Luke 2:25 NIV). Yet Simeon did not

experience shalom (peace), a deep sense of completeness, until he saw Jesus.

While holding Jesus in his arms, Simeon broke into a song of praise, expressing full satisfaction in God: "Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations" (Luke 2:29-31 NIV).

He had peace because

he foresaw the future hope of the whole world.

As we see all the turmoil going on in the world right now with the Pandemic and the demonstrations for justice let us continue to focus and celebrate the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, the promised Savior, and rejoice in God's gift of peace.

Before He went to the cross, the Bible says that 'Jesus...took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. For we shall stand firm on the solid rock.....


