Palm Sunday - A boy who met the Saviour by Pastor Joseph Daniel (originally written for Palm Sunday 1997)

"Mum, Dad, Brothers and Sisters, all went to Jerusalem. On our way everyone started talking about this great man from Galilee. How everyone he touched was healed, and even people raised to life who were dead. He fed thousands with a boy's lunch and even had left-overs.

He is so great that even the leaders were afraid of Him. So much that they were trying to find a way to kill Him. In the distance we could see a crowd of people coming from the mount of Olives up to Jerusalem.

As they drew near we saw

the Great Healer on a donkey and people running in front, throwing their expensive coats on the road for Him to ride on. My dad took off his coat and put it down and I took off mine and put it on the road for Him to ride over.

People were breaking palm branches and waving as they would for a victorious King. The people were praising God saying: "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the Lord!"

I knew He loved us because I was told he took children in His arms and blessed them. Therefore we

followed Him in the temple, praising and worshipping God. This was the greatest time in my life and my first visit in the temple. Us children just shouted with all our might: "Glory To God! Hallelujah! Praise the Lord for He is Good!" They told Him to make us keep quiet in the House of God but He did not.

I looked on the Master and I could see the Glory of God shining in His loving face and we just shouted praises to God even louder.

I wished everyone knew the joy of praising the Lord."

Thought for the month Christ in you - the hope

**'Let us go with you, for we have
heard that God is with you.'
Zechariah 8:23**

The prophet Zechariah wrote, 'Many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek the Lord saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you"' (Zechariah 22-23).

When people see God at work in your life, they'll be drawn to you.

This happened to a cook and dish washer named Nicholas Herman. Wiped out and worn out from life, he worried constantly about whether or not he was even saved. Then one day as he was looking at a tree, he was struck by the truth in Psalm 1:3 – that the secret to growing spiritually is in being rooted and grounded in God. So he decided to make his life an experiment in what he called 'the habitual, silent, secret conversation of the soul with God.'

Today he's better known as Brother Lawrence, the name his friends gave him. You might have heard of him and his book. Although he spent his life in obscurity working in a monastery kitchen, how he interacted with God made people from around the world long to know God like he did. They would queue to watch him wash dishes because the presence of God was so strong around him. His friends said he 'found God everywhere...as much while repairing shoes as...praying with the community.' After he died they made a book of his letters and conversations called The Practice of the Presence of God. It's one of the most widely read books of the last four centuries.

Jesus said, 'If I am lifted up I will draw all peoples to Myself' (John 12:32). The more you cultivate the presence of God in your life, the more others will be attracted to Him.

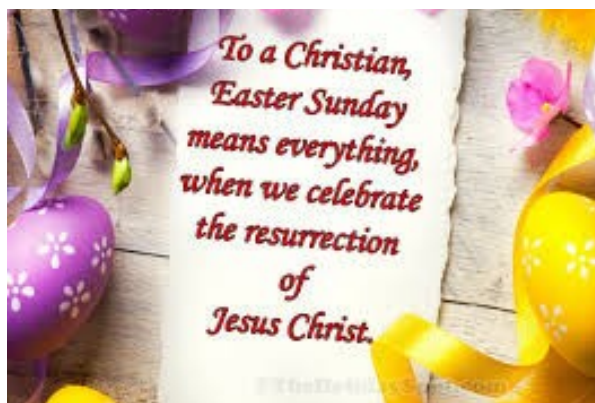
