## BECOME A WORSHIPPER

“But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.”

John 4:23 ESV

Our verse for this month gives us some essential information. The Father is seeking worshippers.

**But, how do you become a worshipper?**

**First** of all, there is no one-size-fits-all. The Bible does not say you must worship God in a certain way. That's because worship is such a powerful outpouring of our hearts towards the Lord that it cannot be limited to words or defined by a song, a shout, or silence.

Jesus said, ‘True worshippers are led by the Spirit. These are the ones the Father is seeking to worship him’ (CEV).

**Second**, God created you to worship Him. Perhaps you have never thought of this – God created us to do the one thing He would not do for Himself – worship! John the Apostle wrote, ‘Thou art worthy to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created’ (Revelation 4:11 KJV).

Nothing brings pleasure to the heart of our heavenly Father more than the love and adoration of His redeemed children.

**Third**, worship can be expressed by anybody, anywhere, anytime. The Samaritan woman as read in the Bible grew up believing that true

worship must be expressed at a sacred mountain called Gerizim, whereas the Jews believed it should be practiced in the temple at Jerusalem. Jesus said it wasn't to be confined to church or a particular day of the week. Furthermore, the psalmist, in his inimitable style, puts it like this: **‘Servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord! Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised’** (Psalm 113:1-3 NKJV).

So, become a worshipper.

# Encouragement

## “The Work was Finished”

**“The cloth that had covered Jesus’ head was folded up.”**  
John 20:7 NLT

In Bible days when you wanted a fine piece of furniture made, you picked someone with a reputation for excellence – a master carpenter or a finish carpenter.

Now, these carpenters had an interesting custom. When a carpenter completed a job, he took off his apron, folded it up, and set it on his finished work, signifying the job was complete. With that picture in mind, we read:

*‘Early on Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. She ran and found Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved. Peter and the other disciple started out*

*for the tomb. They were both running, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He stooped and looked in and saw the linen wrappings lying there, but he didn’t go in. Then Simon Peter arrived and went inside. He also noticed the linen wrappings lying there, while the cloth that had covered Jesus’ head was folded up and lying apart from the other wrappings. Then the disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in, and he saw and believed – for until then they hadn’t understood the Scriptures that said Jesus must rise from the dead’ (vv. 1-9 NLT).*

Noting the words **‘the cloth that had covered Jesus’ head was folded up’**. The master carpenter had finished the job. Our salvation was complete. You do not have to work to be saved, you only have to put your trust in Christ, and your sins are forgiven and your place in heaven assured. Hallelujah!
