## YOU HAVE ACCESS TO GOD

“Let us then approach God’s throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.” Hebrews 4:16

If you have been to an amusement park you know that it is designed to transport you to another world. The goal of the entire experience is to help you lose yourself in its fun and excitement.

So let’s walk right up to him and get what he is so ready to give. Take the mercy, accept the help’ (Hebrews 4:14-16).



**“Stop Waiting for Perfect Conditions”**

*'He who observes the wind will not sow.'*  
**Ecclesiastes 11:4**

Too many of us stand on the dock waiting. We want the ship in place, the gangplank perfectly positioned, the weather right, and an engraved invitation before we are willing to launch out. It will never happen.

Dreams do not move toward us, we have to move toward them. One author writes 'It is time to stop waiting for perfection, inspiration, permission, reassurance, someone to change, the right person to come along, the children to leave home, the new administration to take over, an absence of risk, someone to discover you, a clear set of instructions, more self-confidence, or the pain to go away.'


