"Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1 v. 6

PCF has just gone through a period of fasting which many have testified of the way they have experienced God working in their life in so many great ways. Others are seeing their walk with God in a new light, new attitudes with focus on a deeper reliance on the Holy Spirit.
