### BEHIND THE VICTORY - HANNAH

Welcome to Tessa Bennett's series on the unsung women of the Bible.

As a devoted Arsenal supporter, finally watching my team lift the Premiership trophy after 22 long years stirred something deeper within me. It was more than football; it was the emotional weight of waiting, hoping, enduring disappointment, and still believing despite the setbacks. It made me reflect on the many stories in Scripture where recognition, breakthrough, or fulfilment did not come quickly. One woman who embodies this journey is Hannah.

For years, Hannah carried the silent pain of barrenness in a culture where a woman's value was often connected to motherhood. While others around her seemed to receive what she longed for, Hannah remained overlooked, misunderstood, and emotionally burdened. Scripture describes her as "deeply distressed," revealing the depth of grief she carried privately year after year. Despite her pain, she continued to pray, hope, and persevere, even when it appeared nothing was changing.

Then, after years of waiting and feeling unseen, Hannah's story shifted.

She became the mother of Samuel, one of Israel's most influential prophets. What once appeared to be a personal struggle became part of a far greater story of purpose and impact. Hannah's quiet faithfulness in obscurity eventually helped shape the spiritual direction of a nation.

There is something profoundly powerful about recognition that comes after endurance. It carries the weight of every disappointment, every near moment, and every season where it almost happened but did not. Much like Arsenal finally lifting the title after decades of waiting, the victory means more because of the journey that preceded it.

Hannah's story reminds us that some of the most influential people are not always the loudest or most visible. Sometimes, the greatest impact is formed quietly through resilience, perseverance, and unwavering faith.
