Huldah - When Influence Comes Looking for You

Sometimes there can be a preoccupation with searching for influence, seeking platforms, recognition and positions of prominence. Yet Huldah's story challenges us to consider that when influence comes looking for you, perhaps the most important question is whether you are ready to speak with integrity when it arrives.

This month's Unsung Hero is Huldah, a prophetess whose story is found in 2 Kings 22:8-20 and 2 Chronicles 34:14-28.

During the reign of King Josiah, the Book of the Law was rediscovered during repairs to the Temple. The king's officials needed to understand its significance, and they went to Huldah. What is remarkable is that she was not the king, the high priest or one of the prominent male leaders surrounding him. Yet those in positions of power recognised the spiritual authority she carried.

Huldah's significance lies in her ability to speak truth without compromise; even when powerful people were listening. She didn't

tailor her message to accommodate the status of her audience. She faithfully communicated what God had revealed, including a difficult word of judgment.

Her story speaks profoundly into contemporary society. We live in a time where influence can sometimes be pursued for its own sake, through platforms, titles, followers and recognition. Huldah reminds us that true influence isn't necessarily something we chase; sometimes it is something that finds us because of who we have become when nobody was watching.

Her life challenges us to ask: If influence came looking for me today, would I have the courage and integrity to speak truth, regardless of who is listening?

Huldah may be considered as an unsung hero, Yet her voice helped shape a nation's response to God.

You don't have to chase influence. Build integrity, and let your influence find you.
